

## UPDATED BRIDGEPARK MANOR COVID-19 POLICY

**DATE:** July 16, 2021 - **Effective:** July 17, 2021

To prevent Covid-19 from spreading and continue to comply with the Government of Manitoba's recommendations we would like to communicate the following updates by Bridgepark Manor:

### **Residents:**

- Activities will continue with the wearing of masks, physical distancing measures and hand sanitization in place. See your activities calendar that came with the July newsletter for further details.
- The dining room will continue to be open with staggered mealtime services, physical distancing measures, and hand sanitation upon entry.
  - **In Phase 1** last names starting with **A** through **K** will eat lunch at 11:30 am and dinner at 4:30 pm. Last names starting with **L** through **Z** will eat lunch at 12:15 pm and dinner at 5:15 pm.
  - **In Phase 2 and Phase 3** last names starting with **A** through **J** will eat lunch 11:30am and dinner at 4:30pm. Last names starting with **K** through **Z** will eat lunch at 12:15pm and dinner at 5:15pm.
  - People who are **fully vaccinated**, may dine with **other fully vaccinated** people at the same table.
  - Masks **must be worn** to the dining room and may be removed **once seated**. When leaving the dining room please wear masks.
  - Room service will still be available upon request; the regular charges apply for this service.
- Up to 5 people are allowed in the game's rooms & libraries at one time, but they all must wear a mask and social distance. Tenants may use the treadmill or bicycle without a mask but must be the only one in the room.
- Multi-Purpose Rooms will continue to not be rented out until further notice. However, the guest rooms **may** be rented out to **fully vaccinated** people.

**Visitors:**

- **All** visitors must complete screening at door #330. Physical distancing and the wearing of a mask is expected throughout your visit.
- Indoors, each household can have up to **5** visitors at a time (with the wearing of a mask and social distancing).
- Outdoors, up to **25** people are permitted for visits. The patio in front of Phase 3 is available for visiting.
- Health care professionals must report directly to the front desk (entrance #330) to complete an active screening test. Upon successful completion of Bridgepark Manors active screening test they may proceed into the building wearing a mask throughout the building.
- All essential service providers and delivery personnel must report to the front desk at entrance 330 to complete an active screening test.

**Staff:**

- Staff members will wear a mask when entering the building and continue to wear the mask in all public areas of Bridgepark Manor.
- Staff who have **not** been vaccinated or started the vaccination process will wear a mask and a shield to protect residents.

**Reminder:**

If you leave Bridgepark Manor, physical distancing and wearing a mask should be adhered to.

If you have flu like symptoms such as a fever, headache, sore throat, coughing, and runny nose remain in your room and call HEALTH LINKS at 204-788-8200 or call your family to have this checked out. Avoid people until you are feeling better.
